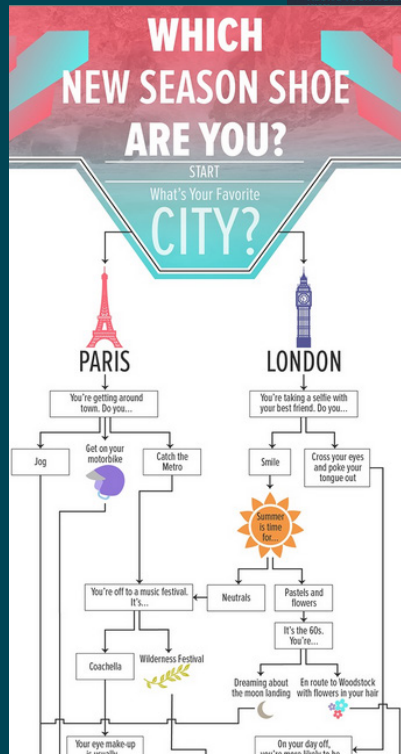
3. FLOWCHART HOW-TO

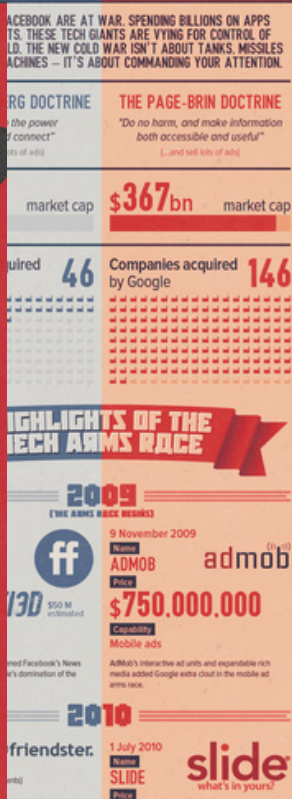
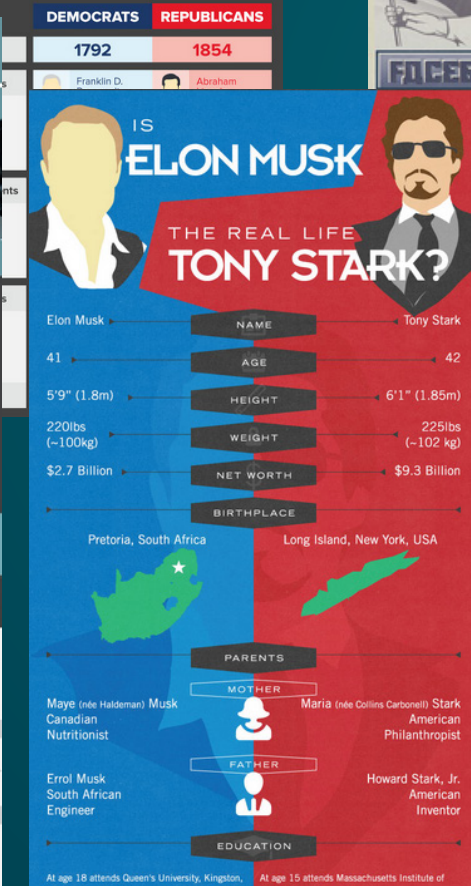
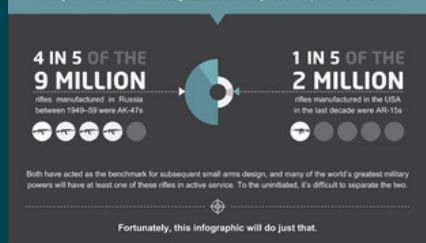
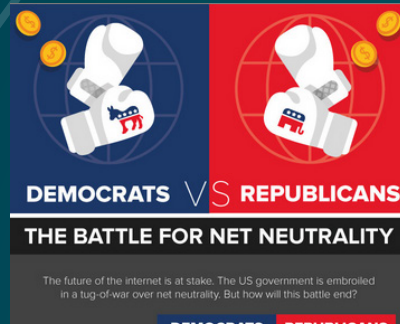
4. VERSUS INFOGRAPHIC

THE SWAN TOWEL

You'll need: 1 bath towel.

HOW TO GROW YOUR OWN INDOOR HERB GARDEN

When it comes to cooking, herbs are the ace up a chef's sleeve. And the best way to always have fresh herbs at your fingertips is to make your own indoor herb garden.

BUILD YOUR PLANTER

Step 1 Choose a container large enough to hold 6 inches tall or larger and make sure it has simple drainage holes.

Step 2 Find a tray for underneath your pot to collect and drain off excess water.

Step 3 Layer the bottom of your container with gravel to ensure suitable drainage.

Step 4 Mix fast-draining potting soil with sand and fill your container about three quarters of the way up.

Step 5 Water the soil lightly until moist but not wet.

Step 6 Add perlite to light rack made from puffed volcanic glass. This will keep your soil from compacting, and also help it drain properly.

THE HERBS

NOTE: This only applies if you're buying young green plants (for seed germination times see the table below).

Step 7 Remove the herbs from their containers, taking care not to damage the roots.

Step 8 Add the plant, making sure you cover to the top of the root ball with soil.

Step 9 Let the soil drain lightly and water well when damp.

COUNTRIES WHO BLOCK SOCIAL MEDIA

WHO'S BANNED FROM WHAT?

Social media isn't just a place for pictures of cats. Uprisings in Egypt and the Ukraine have shown that it is also a place where people can band together to create revolutions.

Some governments around the world feel threatened by this, and so have limited internet usage in their respective countries.

Here's a quick snapshot of just a few countries censoring social media today.

HOW TO GET AROUND THE BANS

Except for North Korea, many people can bypass the bans and access social media through:

- PROXY SERVERS**
These change the location of where you sign in to different websites. These services can either be free or paid for.
- VPNS**
A VPN (virtual private network) provides encrypted links directly to private networks in other countries, allowing computers to behave as if it were in another country.
- BROWSEES**
The most popular anonymous browser is Tor. Traffic is routed through the Tor network, where a number of encrypted routes cover your tracks so no observer is able to tell where data is coming from.

GLOBAL GUIDE TO TIPPING

When a service charge isn't included in the bill, many of us are stuck with that post-dining quandary of how much to tip. And with so much variation in tipping habits across the globe, it's no wonder there's so much confusion.

TIPPING AROUND THE WORLD

Whether you're a jet-setting diner or just curious about tipping customs around the world, here's a failsafe guide to gauging your gratuity.

EUROPE

In France, a service charge of 15% is normally added, which you can see itemized on your bill.

In Germany, a 69% always tip.

INTERNET CENSORSHIP WORLD MAP

The Internet, and our freedom to use it as we please, is a contentious issue. Whereas access in some countries can be unrestricted for any material, its design legal, in others censorship ranges from governments' dissemination of political opinion, to blacklisting pornographic media websites.

Legend:

- Light grey: Limited access with blocks and monitoring on many sites
- Dark grey: Evidence of censorship legal content
- Medium grey: Low restriction levels
- Dark grey: Medium restriction levels
- Black: Access with heavy restrictions, censorship and sanctions
- Yellow: No access, country with heavy censorship
- Light grey: Data not available

THE GAY MARRIAGE WORLD MAP

In April 2001 an event took place that changed the world we live in forever. The first same-sex marriage took place in Amsterdam. Since the Netherlands became the first country to allow same-sex marriages 12 years ago, another 15 countries have followed suit, with certain states in the USA, parts of Mexico and the latest being the Australian Capital territories legalizing same sex marriages.

It would, on the surface appear more countries will change their law to allow same-sex unions, however there are still countries where homosexuality is punished with imprisonment and in some cases death.

Here is a list of the countries and their laws and status on Gay and Human rights.

STATUS ON GAY AND LESBIAN MARRIAGES

- Blue: Gay Marriage legal
- Light blue: Same-Sex Union
- Green: Same-Sex marriages recognized
- Light green: No Laws Allowing Same-Sex Unions or Criminalizing Homosexuality
- Yellow-green: Homosexuality Criminalized
- Yellow: Death Penalty for Homosexuality

15 WAYS TO BEAT JET LAG

BEFORE YOU GO

- Change your sleep routine:** Your circadian rhythm responds to your eyes detecting light. Controlling your exposure to natural and artificial light can help change it.
Going west? Start going to bed later a few days before travel.
Going east? Start going to bed earlier.
- Wear sunglasses:** Your circadian rhythm responds to your eyes detecting light. Controlling your exposure to natural and artificial light can help change it.
- Plan a stopover:** If possible, try to have a stopover on the way to allow the body to adjust gradually to the new time zone.
- Keep calm:** Stress can make jet lag worse, but little things such as check-ins online can alleviate worry.

DURING YOUR FLIGHT

- Time your activities:** Try to eat and sleep according to the local time of your destination, phase-shifting your circadian rhythm forwards or backwards.
- Use remedies with caution:** Sleeping medication isn't recommended as it won't help your body adjust naturally to new sleep patterns.
- Drink water:** Dehydration makes jet lag symptoms worse. Avoid alcohol and caffeine – they dehydrate you.
- Get comfortable:** Use earplugs and an eye mask to help create the right conditions for sleep.
- Keep active:** When flying long distances, take walks around the cabin and stretch regularly.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- Spending the day outdoors:** Exposure to daylight helps you adjust to the new time zone quicker.
- Going west?** Get more morning light when you arrive and avoid the afternoon sun to shift your circadian rhythm backwards.
- Going east?** Seek afternoon light instead to move it forwards, towards the 'sleep phase'.

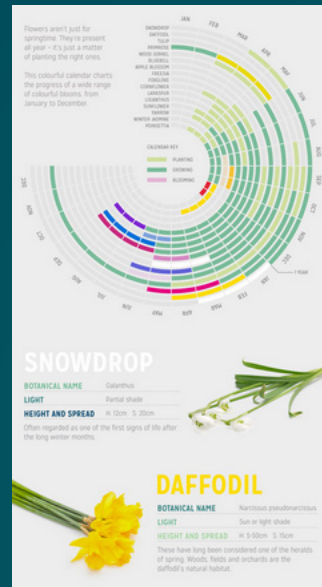

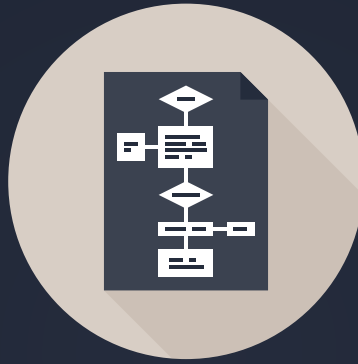
